CIMC Workin' Skills into Careers Project Update



Two training sessions were completed by the CIMC WorkinqSkills into Careers (WSC) project in December, including a client session at the Coyote Valley Reservation facilitated by the Ukiah Field Office (UFO), and a staff session in Sacramento, CA facilitated by Dr. Steve Parese.

During the staff session on December 3, 2015, eight CIMC staff members and two volunteers became new certified soft skill trainers. Each certified trainer is now able to teach the Workinqwith Tradition+ curriculum to CIMC service areas and conduct trainings in soft skill topics such as conflict resolution, time management, goal setting, and understanding work culture. 
