- Endorsement by Tribe of which applicant is a member or employee (A sample endorsement letter is included in Candidate Application Kit.)

OR

- Referral by the CIMC Workforce Development Program as a program participant (Visit www.cimcinc.org for information on the CIMC Workforce Development Program.)

AND

- American Indian heritage (verifiable)
- 21 years of age or older

This application process is competitive and applications must be complete to be considered. Class size is limited.

Applicants selected to receive training must agree to participate in CIMC's Workforce Development Program intake/eligibility process and attend all four sessions.
